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## PUBLIC NOTICE

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Effective thirty (30) days from the date of publication High Plains Power, Inc. is replacing the Standby and Supplemental Service rate with the Startup and Maintenance service – Whole Generation Facilities rate with the Startup And Maintenance Service – Wholesale Generation Facilities rate.. In addition, High Plains is adding a new rate for Standby and Reserve Power Service for Over 1000 kW.

The Startup And Maintenance Service – Wholesale Generation Facilities rate applies to startup and maintenance power service provided at various service levels for wholesale generation facilities.

The Standby and Reserve Power Service for Over 1000 kW rate applies for standby and reserve power service provided at various levels for generation and co-generation facilities in excess of 1000 kW.

Copies of the new rates can be obtained from High Plains Power, Inc.'s office in Riverton, Wyoming, and on its website.

According to the Wyoming Public Service Commission, “if within thirty (30) days following the date of this publication of notice, a complaint signed by not less than 5 percent (5%) of the member owners in a rate class is filed with the cooperative electric utility, a hearing shall be conducted by the utility’s board of directors, to attempt to resolve the complaint. On request by a member owner, for the exclusive purpose of preparing a complaint pursuant to this subsection, and in compliance with the cooperative’s bylaws, the electric cooperative utility shall provide a list to the member owner which includes names and contact information of all member owners included in the rate class of the requesting member owner.”
