03-20-2020 COMMISSIONER SPECIAL MEETING PROCEEDINGS

The Board of County Commissioners met at the above date beginning at 3:00 p.m. Those present were Chairman Fred Frandson, Members Aaron Anderson and Terry Wolf, Clerk to the Board Mary Grace Strauch by phone. County Attorney John Worrall and Divisional Director Jason Monday by phone.

The purpose of the special meeting was to discuss renewing the contract with AirMedCare. The contract would be for a three year period starting March 31, 2020 and ending March 31,, 2023. The last day to renew the contract is March 31, 2020, which is before the next regular commissioner meeting.

The Wyoming State Statutes have changed in regards to air ambulance memberships and require the air ambulance service to become a disability insurer company, which would end the benefit to the citizens of Washakie County regarding not receiving an invoice for a life flight at the end of the existing contract.

There is no price increase for the next three years and the remainder of the current contract has been prorated into the total amount due \$111,002.85. If AirMedCare Network no longer provides or is prohibited from providing services in Washakie County, WY, AirMedCare Network will offer the county a prorated refund of the fees.

A motion was made by Commissioner Anderson and seconded by Commissioner Wolf to approve the AirMedCare contract for \$111,002.85 for the term of March 31, 2020 to March 31, 2023. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Wolf and seconded by Commissioner Anderson to adjourn the meeting at 3:15 PM. Motion carried.
