
PUBLIC NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that the State of Wyoming, Department of Environmental Quality, Division of Air Quality, proposes to issue a modified Wyoming Air Quality Standards and Regulations (WAQSR) Chapter 6, Section 3 operating permit to the following applicant for the Worland Plant #02 in Washakie County, Wyoming:

The Worland Plant #02 is located in Section 24, Township 47 North, Range 93 West, Washakie County, Wyoming (in Worland, Wyoming). The facility is involved in beverage can manufacturing.

This permit is being modified to incorporate requirements of a recently issued construction permit. This modification reflects estimated increases in yearly potential emissions of 16 tons of VOCs. Only the modified portions of the permit are open for public comment.

Interested parties may examine the draft permit, permit application, and statement of basis for the permit online at the Division's website (<https://openair.wyo.gov>), utilizing facility ID F000258 and permit number P0029883 under permits. Public comments or a request for a hearing must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. local time (Mountain) on May 17, 2021. Requests for a hearing shall be in writing and shall include the name and contact information of the person requesting the hearing, a brief statement identifying the purpose of the request, and a brief statement of the issues to be discussed. For the duration of the state of emergency declared by Governor Gordon on March 13, 2020, public hearings will be conducted telephonically. Written public comments or requests for a hearing should be directed to the Administrator, Division of Air Quality, Department of Environmental Quality, 200 West 17th Street, Cheyenne, Wyoming 82002.
