REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

General Information

Washakie Rural I&SD is seeking an engineering firm to provide services which shall include at a minimum to update probable costs and provide revisions/additions to the 2017 WWDC South Worland Level 1 Master Plan Study for the purpose of completing a Preliminary Engineering Report (PER) to the standards required by USDA-Rural Development (1780-2) for the purpose of securing a USDA-RD Search Grant.

An initial contract and scope of work will be for a Preliminary Engineering Report accepted by USDA-RD. A future proposed project is to upgrade the distribution system area previously known as South Worland Water Users to bring the distribution system up to the district's standards.

Because USDA-RUS is the source of funding for the Search Grant, and a probable funding agency for the project, an EJCEC E-525 "Agreement Between Owner and Engineer for Study and Report Professional Services" should be used in the initial stages of a contract.

Scope of Work Statement

Upon Washakie Rural I&SD securing adequate funding for a project to upgrade the distribution system area previously known as South Worland Water Users to bring the distribution system up to the district's standards, a separate Scope of Work and contract may be negotiated for design and construction management depending on the services provided for the Preliminary Engineering Report.

Technical Requirements

Proposals shall include as a minimum the following information:

- Prior experience in projects of this type within past 7-10 years
- References for at least 3 of the projects listed
- Listing of qualification of staff to be assigned to this project and availability of the proposed Project Manager for interview.
- Rate schedule of applicable costs.
