CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT A

This amendment will remove the constitutionally specified limit on the amount of debt a municipality can create for sewer projects and would allow the legislature to prescribe by law the debt limit for municipal sewer projects.

CAMPAIGN REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

THE LAST DAY TO FILE A CAMPAIGN RECEIPT REPORT IS OCTOBER 27, 2020. ALL CANDIDATES, CANDIDATES CAMPAIGN COMMITTEE AND POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEES MUST FILE THIS REPORT SEVEN (7) DAYS BEFORE THE GENERAL OR GENERAL ELECTION AS PER STATE STATUTE 22-25-106 (a) (i) and 22-25-106 (b) (i). ALL CANDIDATES, CANDIDATES CAMPAIGN COMMITTEE AND POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEES SHALL FILE A STATEMENT OF CAMPAIGN RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURES AMENDMENT REPORT BY NOVEMBER 13, 2020. All state candidates must file with the Secretary of State, county and municipal offices with the County Clerks Office.

If a candidate fails to file a full and complete at receipts report in the time required, a vacancy in nomination will occur and the candidate may be charged with a criminal offense as provided in 22-26-112. Failure to file within one month of the receipt of late filing notice will make the candidate INELIGIBLE to run as a candidate for any state or local office for FOUR (4) YEARS and until the required statement is filed and a late fee is paid.
