## GENERAL ELECTION PROCLAMATION FOR 2018 WASHAKIE COUNTY

OCTOBER 22, 2018 LAST DAY TO REGISTER TO VOTE AT COUNTY CLERK'S OFFICE FOR GENERAL ELECTION. MAY REGISTER AT POLLS ON GENERAL ELECTION DAY WITH PROPER IDENTIFICATION.

ONLY QUALIFIED ELECTORS ARE ALLOWED TO VOTE ON ELECTION DAY. ABSENTEE VOTING IS ALLOWED BEFORE GENERAL ELECTION DAY.

POLLS OPEN 7:00 AM TO 7:00 PM

CORRECTION FROM PRIMARY ELECTION PROCLAMATION ON FILING DATES FOR SCHOOL BOARD, FIRE DISTRICT, CEMETERY DISTRICT AND CONSERVATION DISTRICT. FILING PERIOD IS FROM AUGUST 8, 2018 THROUGH AUGUST 27, 2018

WASHAKIE COUNTY 4% LODGING TAX PROPOSITION

Shall Washakie County continue a lodging tax at the rate of 4% upon lodging of 30 days or less, in hotels, motels, tourist courts, trailer parks, campgrounds, dude ranches and outfitters, and similar establishments providing accommodations or space for transient visitors and tourists as set forth in Section W.S. 39-15-204(a) of the State of Wyoming

ONE (1%) PERCENT GENERAL PURPOSE TAX

Shall Washakie County, State of Wyoming, be authorized to adopt and cause to be imposed a one percent (1%) general purpose sales tax, effective July 1, 2019, on retail sales of tangible personal property, admissions and services within the county as authorized by Wyoming State Statute Section 39-15-204 (a) (i); the revenue will be used as general revenue in accordance with Joint Binding Resolution #337.

### HANDICAPPED AND ELDERLY

If you require assistance to vote by reason of blindness, disability, or inability to read or write, a person of your choice may give you assistance. Also, if you have questions regarding the accessibility of your polling place, please contact the County Clerk's office at 347-3131.

### CAMPAIGN REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

THE LAST DAY TO FILE A CAMPAIGN RECEIPT REPORT IS OCTOBER 30, 2018. ALL CANDIDATES, CANDIDATES CAMPAIGN COMMITTEE AND POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEES MUST FILE THIS REPORT SEVEN (7) DAYS BEFORE THE GENERAL ELECTION AS PER STATE STATUTE 22-25-106 (a) (i) and 22-25-106 (b) (i). ALL CANDIDATES, CANDIDATES CAMPAIGN COMMITTEE AND POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEES SHALL FILE A STATEMENT OF CAMPAIGN RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURES BY NOVEMBER 16, 2018. All state candidates must file with the Secretary of State, county and municipal offices with the County Clerks Office. A candidate must file the statement before receiving a certification of election.

If a candidate fails to file a full and complete statement of receipts and expenditures in the time required, a vacancy in nomination will occur and the candidate may be charged with a criminal offense as provided in 22-26-112. Failure to file within one month of the receipt of late filing notice will make the candidate INELIGIBLE to run as a candidate for any state or local office for FOUR (4) YEARS and until the required statement is filed and a late fee is paid.
