ENLARGEMENT ELECTION OF THE WASHAKIE RURAL IMPROVEMENT AND SERVICE DISTRICT

DATE OF ELECTION: NOVEMBER 6, 2018

TIME OF ELECTION: 7:00 AM TO 7:00 PM

PLACE OF ELECTION: COMMUNITY CENTER – BOARD ROOM

A petition was filed on April 26, 2018 with the Washakie County Commissioners to enlarge the boundaries of the Washakie Rural Improvement and Service District. The boundaries of the proposed enlargement of the district are described as follows: Lands in T48N-R92W and are more specifically described in Resolution No. 338 that was signed on July 20, 2018 and available at the County Clerk's office.

Washakie Rural Improvement and Service District landowners and electors and South Worland Water Users landowners and electors within the parcel of land noted above will be eligible to vote as electors or landowners of the parcels.

Those voting for a trust, corporation, partnership, or association must present an affidavit as written authorization filed with the county clerk setting forth a general legal description of the property owned, the street or common name address for the property, that name or names of all owners of the property described, a statement that the person signing the written authorization is the only person having authority to act on behalf of the owner or owners of property.

Filing Office: Washakie County Clerk, P.O. Box 260, Worland, WY 82401. Forms may be picked up at the office between the hours of 8:00 am and 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday.

Offices to be elected to the Washakie Rural Improvement and Service District: Two (2) Temporary Board members. Expiration March 2019. These positions will than appear on the March 2019 directors election ballot as a two year and four year term.

Filing Period: August 8, 2018 through August 27, 2018

Absentee voting will be made available at the County Clerk's office between the hours of 8:00 am and 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday until November 5, 2018 at 5:00 pm. Ballots will be available on September 21, 2018. A separate request for absentee ballot will need to be presented to the county clerk for this election either by mail, fax or phone call.

No special voter registration shall be held. Any voter not otherwise registered who makes an affidavit evidencing his qualifications to vote is deemed registered for the election.
