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## REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

The Board of Commissioners for Washakie County is requesting proposals for the geotechnical and engineering evaluation of a retaining wall failure for a portion of the bike path along Airport Road in Washakie County. A firm submitting a proposal shall have successful experience with designing and evaluating the performance of retaining wall structures. Proposals shall include examples of previous projects of a similar nature.

Anticipated start date is October 15, 2019 and scheduled completion date is April 1, 2020.

Scope of work shall include the following:

1. Geotechnical, engineering and survey work necessary to evaluate the cause of failure of an approximately 300-foot section of the bike bath along Airport Road,
2. Conceptual designs and construction and engineering cost estimates of potential reconstruction or repair alternatives,
3. Surface inspection of the integrity of the other retaining wall locations along the bike path, and
4. Preparation of geotechnical logs, engineering reports, conceptual designs and cost estimates for review by the Board of Commissioners.
