## PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act and the Wyoming Public Service Commission's (Commission) Rules, notice is hereby given of the Application of Wyoming Gas Company, a division of Natural Gas Processing (WGC or the Company), to address the impact of the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017 (TCJA).

WGC is a public utility as defined in Wyo. Stat. § 37-1-101(a)(vi)(D), subject to the Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 37-2-112.

On May 24, 2019, WGC filed its Application requesting Commission approval to implement a Federal Income Tax Adjustment (FITA); modify associated tariff sheets; and to return the amounts owed to customers "catch-up credit" for the period of January 1, 2018 to July 1, 2019.

WGC states the resulting FITA sur-credit is \$0.01077 per CCF for Residential customers, \$0.00983 per CCF for Small Commercial customer and \$0.00863 per CCF for Large Commercial customers.

WGC states the "catch-up credit" refund for the period of January 1, 2108 to July 1, 2019, for each customer class is as follows: Residential - \$101,198.64, Small Commercial - \$21,614.65, Large Commercial - \$46,984.12, for a total of \$169,797.41.

This is not a complete description of the Application. Interested persons may inspect the Application at WGC's offices located at 101 Division Street, Worland, Wyoming or at the Commission's offices in Cheyenne, Wyoming during regular business hours.

Anyone desiring to file a public comment, statement, intervention petition, protest or request for a public hearing in this matter must do file with the Commission in writing on or before June 27, 2019. Any intervention request filed with the Commission shall set forth the grounds of the proposed intervention or request for hearing as well as the position and the interest of the petitioner in this proceeding.
