## ORDINANCE NO. 857

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WORLAND, WASHAKIE COUNTY, WYOMING, INCREASING THE CITY OF WORLAND SEWER RATES FOR THE WYOMING BOYS SCHOOL TO ESTABLISH DEPRECIATION RESERVE FOR FUTURE LINE MAINTENANCE AND REPLACEMENT BY SUPPLEMENTING SECTION 23-63 BY ADDING A NEW SUBSECTION "D" OF THE WORLAND CITY CODE. ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH ARE HEREBY REPEALED.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WORLAND, WASHAKIE COUNTY, WYOMING.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Worland received an Auditor's Report in 2019, wherein it is highly recommended that the City establish depreciation reserve for the purpose of providing a separate account for sewer line maintenance and replacement for the Wyoming Boys School, as required by Wyoming Statutes Section 15-7-407; and

**WHEREAS**, said depreciation reserve will be placed into a separate account to be used for the sole purpose of sewer line maintenance and replacement for the Wyoming Boys School when the costs of the maintenance or replacement exceed the sum of \$12,000.00.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in view of said recommendation, the City does hereby establish a Wyoming Boys School depreciation reserve rate as follows, to-wit:

**SECTION 1:** Worland City Code Section 23-63 is hereby supplemented by adding the following subsection, to-wit:

- D. Wyoming Boys School Sewer Line Depreciation Reserve: The Wyoming Boys School shall pay a monthly depreciation reserve for future sewer line maintenance and replacement when the cost exceeds the sum of \$12,000.00 per occurrence or replacement. The Wyoming Boys School shall be charged the sum of \$1,616.25 each month for depreciation reserve which is in addition to the monthly base sewer charge. The proceeds collected for depreciation reserve will be placed into a separate interest earning bank account to be used only for the purposes addressed above and only for the Wyoming Boys School.**

**SECTION 2:** If any portion of this ordinance is held or found to be invalid, the remainder of the ordinance shall continue to be in full force and effect.

**SECTION 3:** All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the City of Worland in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 4:** This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect on **APRIL 1, 2021**, after having been published in the Northern Wyoming News.
