Sealed Bids for the construction of **The Worland Municipal Airport Taxilane C Widening Project Phase I**, will be received by the City of Worland, at the office of the City Clerk, 829 Big Horn Ave., P.O. Box 226, Worland, WY 82401, until 11:00 am local time on April 16, 2019. Hand delivered bids will be accepted ONLY on the date of the bid opening. The bids will be publicly opened at 11:00 am on April 16, 2019 at the Office of the Clerk's Office at the Worland City Hall located at 829 Big Horn Ave., Worland, WY 82401.

The project consists of construction of a 45' x 457' aircraft taxi-lane. The work involves 1,800 CY of unclassified excavation, 580 CY of subbase, 440 CY base course, and 540 tons of hot mix asphalt. The work also includes asphalt demolition and striping. No bids will be received after the specified hour and date, and may not be withdrawn after the time fixed for opening them. The owner reserves the right to waive irregularities in the bids and reject any and all bids. No bids will be considered in which the Proposal, Specifications or any provisions have been modified. Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a unit price basis, as indicated in the Bid Form. The bidder must supply all information required by the bid or proposal forms and specifications.

Each bid must be accompanied either by a certified check, payable to the City of Worland in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid, or by a Bid Bond in a like amount and executed by an approved surety company. The check or bond will be retained by the Owner as liquidated damages if the successful bidder refuses or fails to enter into contract and performance bond in accord with his bid within fifteen (15) days after date of notification of award.

Minimum wage rates as established by the Secretary of Labor are applicable to the work performed on this project.
