CAMPAIGN REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

THE LAST DAY TO FILE A CAMPAIGN RECEIPT REPORT IS AUGUST 9, 2022. ALL CANDIDATES, CANDIDATES CAMPAIGN COMMITTEE AND POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEES MUST FILE THIS REPORT SEVEN (7) DAYS BEFORE THE PRIMARY OR GENERAL ELECTION AS PER STATE STATUTE 22-25-106 (a) (i) and 22-25-106 (b) (i). ALL CANDIDATES, CANDIDATES CAMPAIGN COMMITTEE AND POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEES SHALL FILE A STATEMENT OF CAMPAIGN RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURES AMENDMENT BY AUGUST 26, 2022 ONLY IF ADDITIONAL FUNDS ARE SPENT OR RECEIVED AFTER THE AUGUST 9, 2022 DATE. All state candidates must file with the Secretary of State, county and municipal offices with the County Clerks Office. A candidate must file the statement before receiving a certification of nomination.

If a candidate fails to file a full and complete statement of receipts and expenditures in the time required, a vacancy in nomination will occur and the candidate may be charged with a criminal offense as provided in 22-26-112. Failure to file within one month of the receipt of late filing notice will make the candidate INELIGIBLE to run as a candidate for any state or local office for FOUR (4) YEARS and until the required statement is filed and a late fee is paid.
