CAMPAIGN REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

THE LAST DAY TO FILE A STATEMENT OF CONTRIBUTIONS AND EXPENDITURES REPORT IS AUGUST 11, 2020. ALL CANDIDATES, CANDIDATES CAMPAIGN COMMITTEE AND POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEES MUST FILE THIS REPORT SEVEN (7) DAYS BEFORE THE PRIMARY OR GENERAL ELECTION AS PER STATE STATUTE 22-25-106 (a) (i) and 22-25-106 (b) (i). AMENDED STATEMENT OF CONTRIBUTION AND EXPENDITURES REPORTS ARE DUE AUGUST 28, 2020. AMENDED REPORTS ONLY NEED TO BE FILED IF THERE ARE ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURES AFTER THE AUGUST 11, 2020 REPORT IS FILED. All state candidates must file with the Secretary of State, county and municipal offices with the County Clerks Office. A candidate must file the statement before receiving a certification of nomination.

If a candidate fails to file a full and complete statement of receipts and expenditures in the time required, a vacancy in nomination will occur and the candidate may be charged with a criminal offense. Failure to file within one month of the receipt of late filing notice will make the candidate INELIGIBLE to run as a candidate for any state or local office for FOUR (4) YEARS and until the required statement is filed and a late fee is paid.
