Sealed Bids for the construction of the LOWER NOWOOD RURAL WATER PROJECT will be received by the Lower Nowood Improvement & Service District at the office of the engineer, Eagle Engineering & Surveying, 908 Big Horn Avenue, P. O. Box 638, Worland, WY 82401, **until 4:00 P.M. local time on Monday, June 1, 2020**, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. The Project consists of constructing a rural potable water system including approximately 26,953 LF of 4" HDPE, 44,130 LF of 3" HDPE, 5,856 LF of 2" HDPE, 11,514 LF of 1.5" and 1,898 LF of 1" HDPE service lines, 12 service connections, 5 roadway borings and 3 creek borings, flushing hydrants, air & vacuum valves, isolation valves, well tie-in including well house, pipe and appurtenances.
