INVITATION TO BID

Big Horn Canal Irrigation District Elk Creek Check & Spill Structure Replacement Project

Sealed bids, entitled "Elk Creek Check & Spill Structure Replacement Project" addressed to the Big Horn Canal Irrigation District (hereafter referred to as the "Owner") will be received by the Owner at P. O. Box 349, or at the office of Russell and Russell, 305 South 4th Street, Basin, WY 82410 until 2:00 p.m. local time on Tuesday, December 3, 2019, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The following is a general description of the work:

Removal and replacement of the existing Elk Creek Check and Spill Structure.

All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Bond in the amount equal to not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid amount, payable to the order of the Big Horn Canal Irrigation District, as liquidated damages in the event said successful bidder shall fail or refuse to execute the contract in accordance with the terms of his/her bid. After a contract is awarded, the successful bidder will be required to furnish separate Performance and Payment Bonds, each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amount.

Plans and specifications are available by download from the Engineer's website, www.sagecivilengineering.com for a fee of \$20.00. The contractor is required to comply with the Wyoming Preference Act for Wyoming Laborers (WY Statute Title 15, Article 2). Preference will be given to Wyoming bidders. The contract will be awarded to the responsible resident making the lowest accepted bid, if such resident's bid is not more than 5% greater than that of the lowest responsible non-resident bidder.

Preference will be given to materials, supplies, equipment, machinery and provisions produced, manufactured, supplied, or grown in Wyoming, quality being equal to articles offered by competitors outside the state.

The Contractor will be required to comply with the wage and labor requirements and to pay minimum wages in accordance with the schedule of wage rates referenced in the Contract.

The Bidder must supply all the information required by the bid documents and specifications.

Bids received after the hour and date specified will be returned unopened.

Except as described in the Instructions to Bidders, bids may not be withdrawn after the time fixed for opening them. The Owner reserves the right to waive irregularities in the bids and reject any and all bids.

A pre-bid conference will be held Tuesday, November 19, 2019, at 10:00 a.m. local time, at the project location, which is approximately 700 feet east of the crossing of U.S. Highway 16/20 and the Big Horn Canal at milepost 191 approximately 4.6 miles south of Basin.
