After voting, ballots are to be returned by mail or delivered in person to 208 Shiloh Road, Worland, WY. Ballots must be received by 5:00 p.m. on November 3, 2020.

Elections for Hot Springs County will be conducted by walk-in ballot only. Any Hot Springs County landowner who wishes to receive an Absentee ballot, should contact the Hot Springs Conservation District at 307-864-3488. The polling place in Thermopolis is 601 Broadway, Suite A, and all voting must be completed by 5:00 p.m. on November 3, 2020.
