Elections for Hot Springs County will be conducted by walk-in ballot only. Any Hot Springs County landowner who wishes to receive an Absentee ballot, should contact the Hot Springs Conservation District at 307-864-3488. The polling place in Thermopolis is 601 Broadway, Suite A, and all voting must be completed by 5:00 p.m. on November 8, 2022.
