NOTICE

The following two tax questions will appear on the General Election Ballot. The election will be held November 8, 2022. The questions are as follows:

Shall Washakie County, State of Wyoming, be authorized to adopt and cause to be imposed the continuation of our local fifth cent, a one percent general purpose sales tax, effective July 1, 2023, on retail sales of tangible personal property, admissions and services within the county as authorized by Wyoming State Statute Section 39-15-204 (a) (i); the revenue will be used as general revenue in accordance with Joint Binding Resolution # 2022-387.

Shall Washakie County renew a lodging tax at a rate of 2 percent upon lodging of 30 days or less, in Hotels, Motels, Trailer Parks, Campgrounds, Dude Ranches, Outfitters, vacation and short term rentals, and similar establishments providing accommodations or space for transient visitors and tourist as set forth section W.S. 39-15-204(a) of State of Wyoming.

Voting precincts will be those as designated for a General Election. Polling places will be open from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm
