In accordance with Chapter 6, Section 2(m) of the Wyoming Air Quality Standards and Regulations, notice is hereby given that the State of Wyoming, Department of Environmental Quality, Division of Air Quality, proposes to approve a request by Crown Cork & Seal USA, Incorporated (CMP000219) to modify the Worland Plant #02 (F000258) by revising the condition in their current permit that limits the volatile organic compound (VOC) content of inside spray coatings that are applied to the aluminum beverage cans produced from 0.77 kg of VOC coating per liter of coating solids to 0.86 kg of VOC coating per liter of coating solids. The Worland Plant #2 is located at 620 North 4th Street, Worland, in Washakie County, Wyoming.
