
PUBLIC NOTICE

ORDINANCE NO. 860

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WORLAND, WASHAKIE COUNTY, WYOMING, INCREASING THE MONTHLY EQUIVALENT DWELLING UNIT (EDU) FEE AS A RESULT OF THE INCREASE SUBMITTED BY THE BIG HORN REGIONAL WATER SYSTEM BY AMENDING THE WORLAND CITY CODE SECTION 23-37-4(B) RATE AND FEE SCHEDULE. ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREIN ARE HEREBY REPEALED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WORLAND, WASHAKIE COUNTY, WYOMING.

SECTION 1: Section 23-37-4(B) of the Worland City Code shall be and is hereby amended by adding the following revised EDU Rate Schedule to subsection B:

B. Equivalent Dwelling Unit (EDU) Fee: Each water Consumer shall pay a monthly EDU fee calculated As follows:

| Tap Size | Rate |

| ¾" | \$ 11.50 |
| 1" | \$ 20.44 |
| 1 ½" | \$ 46.00 |
| 2" | \$ 81.78 |
| 2 ½" | \$ 127.78 |
| 3" | \$ 184.00 |
| 4" | \$ 327.11 |
| 5" | \$ 511.11 |
| 6" | \$ 736.00 |

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: If any portion of this ordinance is held or found to be invalid, the remainder of the ordinance shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 4: Whereas it is hereby declared that an emergency exists in that this Ordinance must be in effect immediately to be enacted retroactively to take effect as of **July 1, 2021**, due to the rate increase of the EDU by the Big Horn Regional Water System; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, and shall be published in the Northern Wyoming Daily News within a reasonable time thereafter.

SECTION 5: The rule requiring ordinances, except emergency ordinances, to have public readings on three (3) different days unless three-fourths (3/4) of the Governing Body vote to suspend the rules as provided by Wyoming Statutes Section 15-1-115, is hereby suspended for the purpose of permitting the adoption of this Ordinances at this meetings.

SECTION 6: In signing this Ordinance, the mayor proclamate that this Ordinance, adopted and approved this **7TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2021**, operates for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and shall become effective immediately upon the date of this proclamation and that this Ordinance shall be published as required by law.

PASSED, APPROVED AND ADOPTED BY THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF THREE-FOURTHS (3/4) OF THE QUALIFIED MEMBERS OF THE GOVERNING BODY ON THE FIRST READING ON SEPTEMBER 7, 2021.
