INVITATION TO BID

Notice is hereby given that the CITY OF WORLAND, WYOMING will receive sealed bids at Worland City Hall, 829 Big Horn Avenue, PO Box 226, Worland, WY 82401, for the 2018 GSB FRICTION STREET SEALING PROJECT on Tuesday, September 18, 2018, at 11:00 AM local time. The work under the Bid Schedule for the project includes sealing the surface of selected city streets with GSB FRICTION SEAL (GSB-88 with fine grit sand).

At the aforementioned time and place, such bids as are received for the project shall be publicly opened and read aloud. Bid forms, specifications and plans may be obtained from the ENGINEER, Donnell & Allred, Inc., 908 Big Horn Ave., P.O. Box 638, Worland, Wyoming, 82401, (307) 347-8276 upon the payment of \$100.00 per set (non-refundable). Bid Documents are also available free of charge on D&A's website, please contact Donnell & Allred, Inc. for access instructions. It is assumed that all bidders will have copies of the Wyoming Public Works Standard Specifications - 2015 Edition. Bids shall be submitted on proposal forms provided in accordance with the contract documents.

Each Proposal shall be accompanied by an acceptable bid bond in an amount equal to five (5) percent of the amount of the Proposal payable to the OWNER as a guarantee that if Proposal is accepted, the Bidder shall execute the Contract and file acceptable Performance and Payment Bonds within thirty (30) days after the award of the Contract.

The OWNER, reserves the right to reject any or all Proposals and to waive any informality, minor irregularity or technicality in any Proposal in the interest of the OWNER. No bid may be withdrawn within a period of thirty (30) days after the date fixed for the opening of bids.

Pursuant to W.S. 16-6-106, "preference is hereby given to materials, supplies, agricultural products, equipment, machinery and provisions produced, manufactured or grown in Wyoming, or supplied by a resident of the state, quality being equal to articles offered by the competitors outside of the state".

The funds which have been programmed for the construction of this project are estimated to be sufficient to provide for the proposed work as shown on the plans, In the event contract unit prices indicate a total cost of the project that is different than the funding programmed, the OWNER reserves the right to negotiate with the low bidder and amend the areas to keep the cost of work within the funds allotted to the project. Notice to proceed for this project, should it be awarded, will be issues as soon as all paperwork is completed, and construction must be completed by Friday, October 05, 2018
